Emergencies: In the event of a medical emergency, we will perform the procedures necessary to save the life of your pet and we will try to reach you as soon as possible. If you have any specific instructions regarding emergency procedures, please let us know before leaving your pet. The owner is responsible for any charges incurred.

Release of boarding pets: Animals will only be released during regular office hours. Animals will not be released after 4:00 PM on Saturdays or on Sundays or holidays.

Boarding: Transmission of contagious disease is a possibility in any kennel. Contagion is uncommon and the diseases are usually mild. Despite our best efforts to avoid transmission, boarding pets can acquire contagious diseases. Owners must be aware of this risk and assume responsibility for any additional medical expenses in treating a pet while boarding and after it has returned home.

External parasites: If Fleas are discovered on animals on admission, they will be treated with an appropriate topical flea product, such as Advantage or Revolution. This will be done at owner expense.
